PSA's (Public Service Announcements)

Hooded (10 minutes) DVD

This is a short film that talks about forgiveness. Only when we forgive each other will we live at peace. The remarkable thing is that we really love our neighbor as ourselves: we do unto others as we do unto ourselves.

Electronic Abuse (5 Minutes) DVD

This film shows how electronic gadgets have changed our lives. Sadly, in this birthday "party", the gadgets seem to be more interesting than family time. Parents and their children seem more involved in their gadgets other than family time.

Drugs (2 minutes) DVD

This is a short film that talks about drugs and peer pressure that most young people indulge in when there is no supervision. It talks about this boy who tries out different drugs that he clearly has never done before and ends up dead.

Short Series:

The Global Gospel (DVD)

The life and teachings of Jesus Christ come alive in this beautifully illustrated video storybook which follows the dramatic narration of the New Testament accounts found in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Redefining the church (DVD)

The Redefining the Church series focuses on having a biblical perspective in all aspects of life. It includes, but is not limited to, sports, marriage, industry, commerce, media, and entertainment. This series is designed for mature Christians.



Injili Ulimwenguni (DVD)

Maisha na mafundisho ya Yesu yalidhihirishwa katika kitabu hiki cha hadithi ambacho kinafuata masimulizi ya agano jipya yanayopatikana karika vitabu vya injili vya Mathayo, Marko, Luka, na Yohana.

Choices (DVD)

Jane a campus student, is in a relationship with Eric. Eric impregnates her and fails to take responsibility. With no hope, this forces Jane to have an abortion. As a result, she gets septic shock forcing the Doctors to perform a hysterectomy. A condition that will make her barren for the rest of her life.

Youth Videos Series (Sheng') (DVD)

The videos are teaching the youths how to develop a habit of trustworthiness in their words and behaviors, to understand how kindness is expressed in practical ways and to teach them how to avoid filthy language and to instead honor God with their speech.

Dramas:

English:

***Tough Choices* (52 minutes) DVD & VHS**

In this drama, Rebecca gets pregnant while in high school and must decide what to do with her baby. Is it only “a bunch of cells”, or much more? Rebecca’s dream of becoming a dentist is wrecked. This “one-night stand” requires “tough choices” to be made not only by Peter and Rebecca but also by their parents. Peter might have to drop out of school due to lack of school fees. How will Rebecca’s family overcome the stigma of having a daughter “in trouble” and who will take care of the child? What does the future hold? *Tough Choices* takes a hard look at a growing problem facing today’s youth, their families and the options that are available to them. (This video is also available in French).

***Promise of Love* (55 minutes) DVD & VHS**

In this sequel to the popular *Tough Choices* drama, Rebecca’s story continues. It is five years later and Rebecca is a single mother struggling to raise her young daughter. She has chosen the easy route to happiness, living with a man who promises to meet her every need. Thanks to a few good friends and a church that reaches out to her, Rebecca realizes that her lover’s broken promises can never compare to God’s *Promise of Love!* (This video is also available in French).



The Distant Boat (60 minutes)

In this drama, Max, a young urban Kenyan has it all: a dream job, a best friend, and a girl he hopes to marry. In the midst of a crisis, Max has a radical encounter with a poor Muslim fisherman named Yusef. Max's whole life and perspective are challenged when he realizes that Yusef and his people have no church and no church witness. Max wonders if God is calling him to be a missionary, but the journey is fraught with obstacles. He must be willing to risk everything- his future, his reputation, and even the love of his life- as he peruses this call. It's a perilous journey of trust and discovery in what it means to be and to send a missionary, and why it is worth the cost

Swahili:

Dume Halisi (Real Bull) (52 Minutes) DVD & VHS

Peter understands that the family is the basic unit of the society. However, raised by strict parents who demanded discipline, he propagates the same tradition adopted from his father of being 'the bull' in his house as opposed to providing leadership in love and humility. His family faces disintegration because he doesn't care for his children and disrespects his wife. Peter's parenting regulations lead his firstborn son astray and also put him in trouble with his relatives, friends and the church.

Weka Rasilmali katika Maisha (Invest in Life) (50 minutes) VHS

When faced with the death of his educated but unemployed son, a father is forced to rethink the traditional practice of saving all his finances for himself instead of investing in the life of his children when they need help in financing their futures.

Shida ya Samweli (Samuel's Problem) (50 minutes) VHS

This is an evangelistic film that shows the devastating effect that sin has on the life of Samuel, an urban white-collar worker in Eldoret, Kenya. However, when sin has knocked him down to his lowest point, he is then able to respond to the teaching about Jesus.

Dini gani Inayofaa? (Which Kind of Religion is best?) (60 minutes) VHS

This is a good film highlighting the difference in two approaches to religion. One way is demonstrated by the conman, John who uses religion for his own ends, while the genuine Christian, Michael, imitates his Lord to those whom he contacts.

Sikia Tafadhali (Please Listen) (15 minutes) VHS

This video confronts a drunkard through direct appeal from his family and community. This drama shows how his actions have brought disgrace and poverty to those who depend on him. (This and *Jukumu* below are on one tape) (See following Kalenjin listing also.)

Jukumu (Responsibility) (15 minutes) VHS

This drama deals with the problem of young men fathering children with their girlfriends and then claiming no responsibility towards the girls or their babies. The video explores different scenarios on how this problem should be dealt with and asks the question: "Have you fathered a child and then run away?" (This and *Sikia Tafadhali* above are on one tape.)



Kifo hadi Uzima (*From Death to Life*) (70 minutes) VHS

Drunkenness and sin brings trouble upon trouble to a rural Kenyan family culminating in the death of their child. This tragedy, however, serves as a wake up call to the family and they respond to Jesus. But life is not easy as the temptations to go back to old habits are ever present. Each individual, and the family as a whole, have to learn how to walk with Christ in the midst of a sinful world.

Dunia bila Wakristo (*World without Christians*) (53 minutes) VHS

This story is about Juma, a successful business man who has done well for himself. He has done this without appreciating God, Christ or Christianity and is satisfied with the world that belongs to him. Falling asleep after a long night of drinking, Juma has a dream. In his dream the world turns into a cruel and uninviting place because no one is just or merciful. There is now a world without Christianity. Witchcraft, prostitution and child slavery are common. Finally Juma realizes that Jesus' followers are good people who have brought righteousness and goodness into an otherwise evil world. He awakes and decides to look for the evangelist who can tell him more about Christ.

Safi Nje, Safi Ndani (*Clean Outside, Clean Inside*) (46 minutes) VHS

Stephen is disgusted by the rubbish in his community and decides to get his church's help in cleaning it up. The success of this "outward" cleanup campaign leads to Stephen's success in teaching that Jesus Christ wants to clean the "inside" of people too! (This and *Moyo wa Esta* below are on one tape.)

Moyo wa Esta (*Esther's Heart*) (9 minutes) VHS

Targeting the rural drunkards, this parable is about Esther, a woman who has allowed her heart to become full of every evil thing. When she finally gets to the end of her rope, she cries out for help. A neighbor woman hears her and helps her to clean up her heart and life. The narration ties this story to the clean up-job that Jesus wants to do in our hearts, if we will let Him. (This and *Safi Nje, Safi Ndani* above are on one tape.)

Dunia, Mtu na Tajiri (*The World, the Man and the Boss*) (43 minutes) VHS

In this drama, a certain man is seeking joy. But, where does he find it? After making wrong decisions in vain, a servant of "Eternal Truth" gives him hope that his master is able to help him out but this means that it will cost him all that he has in life.



Kalenjin:

Gondit (*Respect*) (36 minutes) VHS

This video is designed for teens and young adults. It is a parable about a young man who loves his bicycle and takes extra good care of it because of his respect for its craftsmanship and usefulness. He does not, however, show the same respect for his body as he engages in promiscuous sex. His brother, however, does show respect for his body and his relationship with his girlfriend, and, as his brother dies of AIDS, ends up with all the blessings of obedience to God - including the bicycle!

Ng'alek Ang'wan che bo Kayanenyo (*Four Points of our Faith*) (25 minutes) VHS

This sermon by Oneal Tankersley is enhanced with visuals and covers the four main points of teachings about Jesus Christ.

1. He is the Word from heaven made flesh - full of grace and truth.
2. He died for our sins.
3. He arose from the dead.
4. He ascended to heaven and is coming again as judge of the living and the dead.

Sobondo Anan Meet (*Death or Life*) (29 minutes) VHS

The lives of two men are highlighted during a two day period. They face the same problems in life but approach them in totally different ways. One is a believer in God and one is a drunkard. The results of both lives are shown and a challenge is presented to the drunkard to repent.

Kaigai Ogas (*Please Listen*) (15 minutes) VHS

This video confronts a drunkard through direct appeal from his family and community. Through drama, a message showing how his actions have brought disgrace and poverty to those who depend on him is revealed. (Also in Kiswahili)

Jesu Kasuldaetab Kipgaa (*Jesus the Fulfillment of Traditional Culture*) (15 minutes) VHS

Traditional Kalenjin culture has much good to commend in it - but it has some ungodly aspects as well. This video tries to communicate to the traditional minded that Jesus fulfills and goes beyond the best ideals of Kalenjin culture - ideals such as respect, harmony, and mercy.

Toretetab Tibikyok (*Help for our Girls*) (25 minutes) VHS

This drama deals with a Christian alternative to the Kalenjin rite of passage for teenage girls of female circumcision. An alternate time of seclusion and training is proposed without any of the destructive cutting performed during the traditional practice.

Torornatetab Jehovah (*The Greatness of God*) (42 minutes) VHS

A sermon by Oneal Tankersley enhanced with video illustrations attempts to inspire awe and worship of God almighty by a consideration of His greatness as displayed in His created world.



Educational Series:

English:

Sacrifice: A Study of the Biblical Doctrine of Atonement with Application in the African Context (10 Lesson Series, 2 tapes, 3 hours) VHS This 10-part series, produced in conjunction with the Nairobi Great Commission School's Extension Program, is designed to introduce students to the basic concepts of sacrifice, as seen in Scripture, and relate those teachings to African cultural practices that will provide redemptive analogies for leading people to Christ. Student workbooks and a teacher's guide are also available to accompany the video course.

Church Resource Library - Foundation Series:

Swahili:

1. ***Ukuhani (Priesthood)*** (30 minutes) (Nos. 1, 2, and 3 all on one tape) VHS Zakayo and his wife are fresh out of preaching school and everyone expects the work of the church to really go forward. However, their eagerness to use their education intimidates the other believers and they begin to leave all the work up to the preacher and his wife. Everyone is frustrated until a wise elder helps them remember that all believers are priests before God and are called to use their gifts in His service.
2. ***Wazee wa Kanisa (Church Elders)*** (40 minutes) VHS In a documentary type style, the subject of church elders is explored through a mixture of interviews of elders who are successfully leading their churches, and scriptural teaching on elders. The principle of servant-leadership and the idea that God uses common men as shepherds of his people are stressed. Topics such as "Who is an elder?" "What is his work?" "What is the role of an elder's wife?" and many more questions are addressed in this teaching video designed to educate and motivate better church leadership.
3. ***Kanisa la Kristo ni Nani? (Who is the church of Christ)*** (30 minutes) VHS This film tries to explain who the church of Christ is as a fellowship and to show the value of the Restoration idea of following Jesus Christ according to the faith and practice of the New Testament.

Church Resource Library - Ministry Series:

English:

Welcoming the Deaf to Worship (55 minutes) VHS

This is a basic course in Kenyan sign language set in the context of drama. The story is designed to introduce Christians to sign language and to hopefully encourage some gifted people to continue in the deaf ministry. In the video, a group of good-hearted Christian people struggle with how they can welcome and integrate the deaf into their congregation.



Swahili:

1. Mchezo wa "Courtship" (The Courtship Game) (35 minutes) (Nos. 1,2, and 3 all on one tape) VHS

In a playful narrator/teacher to actors format, basic Christian teaching and culturally appropriate common sense instruction regarding proper male - female relationships is taught to a group of three couples. An emphasis is laid on the reasoning behind sexual purity and on involving parents, and the church in the courtship process.

2. Mchezo wa Ndoa (The Marriage Game) (43 minutes) VHS

A companion production to "The Courtship Game" above, this video uses the setting of a volleyball game to stress the need for teamwork in marriage. Three major points are presented from biblical basis. 1) That marriage is a lifetime commitment, 2) That marriage is an exclusive sexual covenant and 3) That husbands and wives need to communicate, communicate, communicate about all areas of their lives with each other.

3. Ndoa ya Heshima au Aibu? (A Marriage of Honor or Shame) (11 minutes) VHS

Two attitudes towards life and marriage are presented in this drama and the audience is encouraged to choose which one they want to model. The first is a relationship of respect and sharing the work and issues of life together as people of faith. The second is one of selfishness, laziness, and abuse without any shared faith to sustain them. The drama ends with hope as those in need of help decide to listen to what the Christian evangelists want to share with them.

Church Resource Library - Development Series:

English:

Mable's Garden Secrets (52 minutes) VHS Mable has a few secrets for successful gardening and shares them freely with her friends in this educational drama. By sharing her secrets, Mable is able to help her friends improve their gardening practices in order to become more productive farmers. The major topics covered in this teaching episode are: intensive gardening practices; options for plant health; wise use of water; new varieties of nutritious vegetables; cash crop options; long-term vegetable storage and safe cooking stoves.

Swahili:

Mable's Garden Secrets (59 minutes) VHS (See description in the English listing above.)

Jiko la Maendeleo (Progress Stove) (17 minutes) VHS This film illustrates the horror of burned children to motivate and instruct parents to build a safer wood burning stove in their homes. An eight-page instruction booklet on how to build the stove is also available to use with the video by writing, (Good News Productions International-Africa, P.O. Box 636, Village Market, Nairobi, Kenya, 00621.)

Jiko la Kuoka Mikate (Bread Oven) (40 minutes) VHS

This video illustrates how to make an oven which can be used to bake bread and scones not just for home use but also as a small-scale business venture. It is useful for those interested in starting a community project or an individual who wants to improve his standards of living.



Jinsi Tunavyotumia Filamu ya Kikristo (How to use Christian Videos) (24 minutes)

VHS This video illustrates how to use Christian videos. Emphasis is placed on the importance of taking care of the equipment. The video also stresses the importance of “Christian ministry” along with entertainment. A lot of emphasis is put on prayer, planning and teaching together with following-up on the viewers so that the film can be used as an effective evangelistic tool.

Dramas:

English:

***Something to Sing About* (87 minutes) DVD & VHS**

Tommy wants to get off the streets that have already trapped his buddy. But nothing is working out for Tommy until his voice captures the heart of Memaw. The sparky old saint’s loving friendship paves the way for redemption and a few growing pains. Tommy’s learning process involves Memaw’s granddaughter, Lilly. The two form a special bond that gets tested by the streets he is trying to avoid. For the first time in his life, Tommy has something to sing about. This fueling drama will have you singing, smiling and will send your spirit soaring as you realize that love changes people.

***The Ride* (98 minutes) DVD & VHS**

Smokey Banks, a former world champion bull rider, has spent the past few years messing up his life with drinking and gambling. Now he’s been assigned community service with Mike Stillwell at the Saguanos Boys Ranch for stealing their truck. Since his only other option is jail, Smokey reluctantly agrees to the terms: stay out of trouble and teach Danny O’Neil how to ride a bull. He has no idea how drastically the people at the ranch are about to change his life.... especially one 14 year old boy.

***A Vow to Cherish* (82 minutes) DVD & VHS**

A Vow to Cherish is the deeply moving love story of John and Ellen Brighton. Together, they face a merciless illness that will either confirm their love or destroy their marriage. Careers and family are thrust into turmoil which can be overcome only by the power of love in action. Phil Brighton, John’s brother and business partner lives too fast to understand why anyone would so desperately cling to a faith and a spouse that will never be the same again. John’s struggle becomes Phil’s glimmer of hope. This film illustrates the importance of living by godly principles in front of a world searching for answers.

***The Climb* (101 minutes) DVD & VHS**

This heart stopping and heart warming story revolves around two hot-shot solo climbers who forge an uneasy friendship in order to reach their ultimate summit. A daring rescue just earned flamboyant Derrick Williams the climb of a lifetime but his dream comes with an unwanted partner, ‘safety man’ Michael Harris who rarely takes life to the edge. The climb of the Chilean Andes escalates into a test of wills, character and sacrifice that pushes both men beyond limits and makes this film an unforgettable adventure experience.



Last Flight Out (83 minutes) DVD

It is an explosive tale of sacrifice and international rescue. It is a thrill-ride through tragedy, lost love and redemption. Hot-shot pilot Dan Hogan is sent deep into the Colombian jungle to rescue missionary doctor Ann Williams. Caught between innocent villagers and a ruthless drugs lord, Ann won't abandon the people she has come to love. Filmed in Puerto Rico, this story blends thrilling adventure and powerful drama with beautiful filmmaking. The message is clear – even a hero needs Jesus Christ as his Savior.

Road to Redemption (90 minutes) DVD & VHS

Amanda Tucker is in a jam when a get-rich-quick scheme blows up in her face. She needs money fast. The only person who can help is a relative stranger- Amanda's almost forgotten, rich grandfather, Nathan but he just wants to go fishing! Amanda's boyfriend teams up with Vincent the enforcer and a professional tracker in order to chase her down. Cadillac splashes, motorcycle gangs and a heart of gold make the *Road to Redemption*, Montana the comedy trip of a lifetime.

Caught (115 minutes) VHS

The true-to-life dramatic story portrays the power of one person caring for another. An 18- year old American, Tim Devon, goes to Amsterdam in search of the father he has never known. His mother reluctantly admits he was born illegitimately out of college romance between her and a Dutch exchange student. In this city, far from his home, he slips into the self destructive drug culture, but is encountered by a single, caring person-- a person of deep faith. This person finds a way to share Christ's message of love, hope and forgiveness in a way Tim could not ignore.

Time to Run (97 minutes) VHS

A suspenseful story of Jeff's (the son) attempt at sabotage in the nuclear generating plant conceived, designed and managed by his father. Jeff feels the plant is a threat to the environment, and he puts his feelings in action. *Time to Run* is the deeply moving drama of the conflicts that are tearing a family apart - conflicts that develop between husband and wife, and between father and son. In an attempt to find freedom from the ever growing hostilities, Jeff takes to the road, hoping to discover some meaning in his confused life.

Cry from the Mountain (76 minutes) VHS

The story centers around the Sanders family. Larry Sanders takes his 10-year old son Cal on a camping trip where he is to break the news that he and his wife Carolyn are getting a divorce. Meanwhile Carolyn, filled with bitterness and unable to forgive her husband for an affair he has had with a woman in his office, considers the option of having an abortion. Through a life-threatening accident and an old hermit living in a deserted mining camp, the course of events is changed for the Sanders. Being thrust into a chain of events that would change their lives forever, the unexpected overtook them at every turn. They are forced to wage a frightening battle for survival.



Scars that Heal (39 minutes) VHS

Dave Roever was a young soldier in Vietnam when over forty percent of his skin was burned off by a grenade exploding in his hand. He went blind in his right eye and deaf in his right ear. Roever's amazing testimony about not only his physical recovery, but his emotional and spiritual healing is one of the most dramatic you may ever see or hear. Through the faithfulness of God and the loving support of his wife, Brenda, he has experienced a restoration so complete that his message has been heard around the world - a message that can bring healing for the deep emotional, mental and spiritual scars tormenting today's generation.

Zack, Jr. (17 minutes) VHS

This popular children's film is a delightful musical that tells the story of Zacchaeus from his son's point of view. Perhaps through this colorful feature, created with puppets, you'll discover...in a little different way...what happened to one Biblical family when Jesus came to visit.

Eye of the Storm (67 minutes) VHS

This film revolves around award-winning TV reporter Tom Edwards and his teenage daughter, Jill. In the wake of his wife's death, Tom immerses himself in his work, leaving Jill hurt and alone. Their struggling attempts to reach out to each other serve only in widening the gap between them. Through a course of events, Tom comes to experience genuine peace in the midst of the storms that engulf him.

For Pete's Sake (108 minutes) VHS

This is a high-spirited drama that shows how one young family dealt with the "irritations" of life...as well as with serious tragedy. Action, music, humor, and edge-of-your seat excitement are brought together in a story that shares meaningful spiritual truths.

The Hiding Place (English and Swahili) (145 minutes) VHS

The true life story of Corrie ten Boom, a former Nazi prisoner, and how she survived. This remarkable story of tragedy and victory share the experiences of a family who was willing to risk all for others. The ten Booms became involved in the Dutch Underground during the German occupation of World War II by hiding Jews in a secret room built in their house, thereby aiding them in their escape from the Nazis. As a result of a raid by soldiers, Corrie's family was taken prisoner and Corrie was sent to the dreaded concentration camp, "Ravensbruck". This is a story of strength, dignity and trust in God. A story for all cultures and walks of life.

The Living Word (English and Swahili) (45 minutes) VHS

Cliff Barrows takes us on a walk through the Bible. This is a film to teach and educate people of all ages about the Bible and the stories within.

Joni (110 minutes) VHS

She was young...vital...just 17, when it happened. A diving accident snapped her neck and left her paralyzed. The months that followed were filled with great physical, emotional, and spiritual struggles for Joni Eareckson. Joni re-creates for you on film her joys and sorrows, her fears and victories, and above all, her faith in the wisdom and certain blessings of a loving Heavenly Father.



The Prodigal (106 minutes) VHS

No one knows when the Stuart family started drifting apart. But their American dream had become a nightmare of broken relationships...a conflict of differing goals...a separation of hearts and minds. And when twenty-one-year-old Greg returned home from his island hideaway, the conflicts within the family only became more obvious...and painful. *The Prodigal* is the dramatic, true-to-life story of one family's struggle to put the pieces back together, and of their discovery that the journey back to each other began with the journey back to their Heavenly Father.

III. Other Christian Video Productions

Prison to Praise (60 minutes) VHS

Based on the best-selling book by the same title, *Prison to Praise* is the gripping story of a restless young soldier and the chaplain who refuses to give up on him. Private Jim Wilkins is a troubled young man whose problems have just gone from bad to worse. After collapsing during training, Jim learns that he has a serious heart problem requiring surgery. Hostile and bitter about his weakened condition, he decides to go AWOL. Soon captured by military police and court-martialed, his situation seems completely hopeless—that is until a base chaplain enters the situation purely by coincidence. Or was it by Providence? Chaplain Merlin seems to understand Jim in a way no one else ever has.

The Teapot (Drama, 104 minutes) VHS

The *Teapot* is an exciting and all too true story about young people today. Like teapots, teenagers are flawless and pure - at first. But careless accidents do happen, and while much of the damage can be repaired, there will always be cracks just like there will always be scars. Only God's grace can help deal with the hurt.

We had Hoped (Drama, 28 minutes) VHS

The followers of Jesus Christ felt hopeless after watching Him die on the cross. Later, their hope was restored when the resurrection facts became clear. Grow in excitement and conviction as you hear the words of hope from the resurrected Christ as he travels the road to Emmaus.

Walk with the Master (Drama, 29 minutes) VHS

Explore with the apostle John the exciting events in the life of Christ. John tells of the lessons he learned, of the miracles he saw, and the crucifixion of Christ he witnessed. Feel the joy John has when he learns of the resurrection...a joy that can be for anyone who walks with the Master.

Once in New York, his so-called friend betrays him and with all his unnecessary spending, his money quickly runs out and he ends up on the street. *Heart of the Father* is a story of unconditional love, betrayal, forgiveness and restoration that will leave you amazed at a father's love for his son.

Fathers & Sons (Drama, 43 minutes) VHS

When Wesley and Thokozani return home for the school holidays, they must make a decision which will change their lives and families forever. In whose footsteps will they follow? This drama is about the explosive relationship between fathers and sons.



Everybody Needs Jesus (Music Video; 4 minutes) VHS

This exciting international music video combines the lyrics of a powerful mission song with dramatic footage of people from around the world. At four minutes in length, this popular video is ideal for a youth rally, church missions fair, faith promise rally, or mission's emphasis day.

The Other Side of the World (Music Video; 4 minutes) VHS

Christian artist Rich Mullins wrote music that reflected his desire to see people fulfill the Great Commission. In this up-tempo music video, Mullins' rich lyrics are combined with powerful video pictures to challenge Christians to go to "the other side of the world" for Jesus Christ.

Living in Hope VHS

This Bible portion guides readers to engage with Scripture and gain spiritual strength in order to handle the crises in their lives. It is available in English a number of African vernaculars as well as on audio cassette.

HIV/AIDS

What can I do? (49 minutes) DVD & VHS

In this video, Canon Gideon Shares with us the lessons he has learned from his journey with HIV. Given the gravity of the HIV epidemic, he calls for more relevant and accurate HIV prevention messages. He urges Christians to do away with judgmental attitudes towards HIV-positive people, and instead to offer them love and support. He encourages churches to spread hope - not fear - through peer education, counselling, home-based care, practical help and prayer.

It's Your Choice (Drama, 56 minutes) VHS

Its Your Choice is a dramatic story revolving around three young people who are confronted with HIV/AIDS and how they deal with the bitter facts. Tefiro and Tendo, who are good friends, make choices regarding careers that take them along different paths. Their lives converge again because of AIDS and because of one woman, Saanyu.

Teaching by Example (by June Crowl)
